Lebanon County Drought Watch Declared

The Commonwealth Drought Task Force has declared a drought watch for 36 counties, including Lebanon County, and has asked for voluntary water conservation in those counties.

Although we have not seen any impact on our well or water production capability, Campmeeting residents, tenants, and guests are asked to be mindful of and take reasonable steps to reduce their water usage.

Members are still asked to continue to water any newly-planted trees on or in the vicinity of their property to ensure their survival through these dry conditions. If watering plants and trees, please do so in the cooler evening or morning hours, and direct the water to the ground at the base of the plant, to avoid wasting water through evaporation.
