MGCA Leaf Collection Procedure



While we continue to determine the best way to pick up our fall leaves with MGCA's current equipment and personnel, we would like to provide the following updates and/or clarification to the current leaf collection procedure on the MGCA website.

Current Leaf Collection Procedure

1. Leaves need to be bagged for pickup as stated in the procedure. Pine needles and pine cones can be placed in these bags. Bags should be placed on driving streets only. If you are self-dumping on the leaf pile behind the garages, the material does not need to be bagged.
2. Other green waste material (sticks, vines, ivy, etc.) can still be placed on driving streets (unbagged) for pickup.
3. Leaf bags are available at the Tabernacle, Library, and Pumphouse. Additional pickup locations may be added. Please take only what you need - we're on the honor system.
