United Methodist Church Elevator Installation

Important Parking Information

This is an exciting time at Mount Gretna United Methodist Church. Construction will be starting on January 30 to install an elevator that will make the church fully accessible for church worship, meetings, and community gatherings in a four-season building.

What does this mean for parking?

Since an external tower will be added to the front of the church for the elevator installation, construction vehicles and materials will be in the parking lot. It is important that the construction-related vehicles have easy access and that there is adequate space for building materials.

The parking lot area directly in front of the main entrance (between Boehm Ave. and the front doors) will be reserved for construction vehicles, workers, and construction material. Also, we are marking the two rows of parking spots closest to the Tabernacle (Glossbrenner Ave.) with 'yellow' paint. These spots will be reserved for church business on Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. - 7 p.m. These spots are needed for Staff, Nursery School Clients, and Visitors attending various meetings and gatherings scheduled at the church throughout the week.

We do ask that you also follow the parking guidelines for Sunday worship and special events. If it is necessary for a vehicle to be towed, the owner will be responsible for the towing and related parking fees.

What does this mean for church building access?

We plan to keep the church building open during construction, but will need to modify the front entrance. We will be removing the large stained glass window facing the

parking lot and installing doors into the rear of the sanctuary. These doors will be used as a temporary entrance until the elevator is complete. Side and rear entrances will be available throughout the project. The walking path along the west side of the building will also be closed.

Construction begins today, and we anticipate it will be completed by summer. Our construction partners, Arthur Funk and Sons, will be following all local building policies and guidelines during this project.

Thank you for helping us as we undertake this project that will benefit the Mount Gretna Community.
